


We concede that providing medical care is a nice gesture but the question we


attempt to address is "what about afterwards?"

WE HAVE HAD many success over the years and want to take this time to introduce you to a few of our projects.

OUR FIRST EXCURSIONS were to Vietnam where we worked in villages and with the Catholic sisters that run the Kim Long Charity Clinic in Hue. Through, what can only be described as Divine Intervention, our founder, Fr. Francis Le, established a relationship between the clinic and Direct Relief International. Because of this relationship, DRI now ships a large cargo container of medications every year to the sisters to supplement their service to the poor. Although we no longer travel to Vietnam, we remain involved as we continue to pay the expenses for ground transportation from the port to the Kim Long Clinic.

ULTRASOUND CAPABILITIES

are a new resource for our work as the Knights of Columbus of Holy Rosary Church, Antioch, donated an ultrasound probe and program that can be run from a laptop. On its maiden voyage, Holy

Rosary parishioner, Peggy Nelson, performed 62 ultrasounds in Peru that allowed our doctors to treat and/or refer with confirmed diagnoses instead of best guesses.

working with Rotary International and the dental college in Iloilo to bring dental care into villages on a long term basis. In June, team members will be presenting at the college and 20 students will be joining us for a few days in the field.

TO FACILITATE DENTAL CARE.

we recently raised funds to buy a portable suction/rinse machine for use during extractions and cleanings. We have also received a directed donation to buy an ultrasonic teeth cleaner that can remove heavy plaque faster and more thoroughly than manual scraping.

vision CARE is always a challenge and a very popular program is the distribution of our reading glasses. Over 700 reading glasses have been distributed over the years. With the upcoming mission, Philippine opthamologists will be joining us to perform eye exams and simple eye surgeries. In addition, we will be bringing over 420 polarized sunglasses to help prevent sun related eye problems for the local fishermen.
